The design scholarship offers a unique opportunity to reimagine the interior of a luxury restaurant in Dubai, drawing inspiration from the sophisticated aesthetic of Dimore Studio, the global architecture and design studio reframing the boundaries in the creation of richly layered, unexpected spaces with its impeccable signature.

Project Brief

In order to participate in the Initiative, candidates are required to produce an interior design project, focused on the topic of Design for Fine Dining in Dubai for Dimore Studio. Applicants are challenged to infuse the space with timeless elegance while incorporating cutting-edge hospitality design trends. Emphasis lies on seamlessly blending luxury and functionality, creating an inviting ambiance that captivates guests. From opulent furnishings to meticulous attention to detail, entrants are encouraged to push creative boundaries while honoring Dimore Studio's signature style. The chosen design should evoke a sense of exclusivity and refinement, setting a new standard for upscale dining experiences in the vibrant city of Dubai.

The projects can be developed in different formats:

- portfolio of the creative idea
- video
- power point presentation
- a slideshow/gallery of images or sketches

Applicants willing to win the scholarship to enroll in the Bachelor of Arts in Interior Design or in the One Year Intensive Programme in Interior Design or Professional Course in Interior Design are kindly asked to comprise in their project the following elements:

- Mood board inspiration
- Creative concept
- Color palette
- Sketches

The projects must be up to a **maximum of 10 slides** if it is a PowerPoint presentation, a portfolio, or a gallery.

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Selection and Assignment Criteria

The Istituto Marangoni Scholarship Committee will select the winners based on the materials provided by the candidate. Materials submitted may not contain images and/or contents which are or could be considered offensive, illegal and/or immoral, nor sexually suggestive materials which promote, also potentially, offensive, profane, violent, obscene, or hate speech based upon the race and/or sex of an individual or group. The rights of use for iconographic materials are considered property of the Candidate.

All accompanying texts and documents submitted shall be written in English. Content in any other language will not be made visible. Istituto Marangoni reserves the right to exclude from participation candidates who submit materials which do not comply with the Regulations.

Deadlines:

April 8th till May 5th, 2024

Candidates interested in the above courses, starting in the September 2024 intake, shall upload the requested materials and finalize the application from 8th April 2024 to 5th May 2024.

Jury:

The Scholarship Committee is composed by Istituto Marangoni leading Faculty members. The Scholarship Committee will unquestionably judge and select the most appropriate candidate profiles. The Jury will sit from 6th till 11th of May 2024 to evaluate the scholarship applications.

Results:

The results will be declared from the week of 13th May 2024 onwards.

Required documents:

Apart from the above required project, the students are required to submit the below documents for evaluation:

For BA Interior Design:

- Personal Statement
- Copy of high school diploma and school certificates (Students who haven't completed high school can submit predicted grades)
- Copy of passport / ID

For One Year Intensive Course:

- Personal Statement
- Any Previous Educational Credentials
- Copy of passport / ID

For Professional Course:

- Personal Statement
- Any Previous Educational Credentials background in Interior Design or Architecture
- CV
- Copy of passport / ID

Terms of Assignment and Acceptance

Please note that all applications received will be evaluated by Jury. Awarded candidates will be asked to confirm the acceptance of the offered deduction within 3 working days and to pay the due enrolment fee within one week from the acceptance day. Lacking feedback and the payment of the enrolment fee from the applicant side, awarded candidate name will be removed from the list of recipients and a place shall not be guaranteed after this time. By accepting the deduction and enrolling into an Istituto Marangoni programme, the candidate implicitly accepts to become an Istituto Marangoni Scholarship testimonial for the following Campaigns, where requested. The regular attendance of the course as well as the maximum commitment on the part of the deduction recipient will be a binding requisite to obtain the final certificate.
